Purpose of the consultation

In accordance with the process established by the Régie in Decision [D-2011-139](#), the Québec Reliability Coordinator (the "Coordinator") is asking Registered Entities and stakeholders for comments on the following standards with a view to their eventual adoption by the Régie:

- IRO-002-6 – Reliability Coordination – Monitoring and Analysis
- IRO-018-1(i) – Reliability Coordinator Real-time Reliability Monitoring and Analysis Capabilities
- TOP-001-4 – Transmission Operations
- TOP-010-1(i) – Real-time Reliability Monitoring and Analysis Capabilities

Additionally, the Coordinator will request the retirement of previous versions of these standards: IRO-002-4 and TOP-001-3.

The Coordinator asks Registered Entities for their opinion on the relevance and impacts of the reliability standards to be adopted or withdrawn.
